

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PICTURE ROCKS,
LYCOMING COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A
FOUR-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF CENTER & WATER STREETS

Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Picture Rocks, Lycoming County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

1. Official stop signs shall be erected in such a position as to face approaching traffic on Center Street at its intersection with Water Street.

2. All vehicles on Center Street approaching the said intersection shall come to a full and complete stop before entering said intersection in accordance with the requirements of the Vehicle Code.

3. Any person who shall violate these provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine as prescribed by the said Vehicle Code.

4. This Ordinance is enacted as the result of a traffic study report dated September 15, 1989.
